The generosity of Napa Valley College alumni and friends over the years has enabled the Foundation to grow an effective scholarship program that has benefitted generations of Napa Valley College students. This Year the Foundation Awarded \$205,225 in scholarships to 133 students. Through gifts to our annual fund the Napa Valley College Foundation was able to provide laptops for students to assist with distance learning and gift cards for first generation students in need of financial assistance.
